We'll depart from **Washington's Union Station** Thursday morning, October 30th with Amtrak's *Palmetto* via the former **Atlantic Coast Line** route of *The Havana Special*, *Florida Special* and the *Champions* to a final destination of Savannah, Georgia in late evening. Once on board relax and enjoy the full range of the comfortable lounge and bedroom seating. Our staff will serve lunch and dinner along with a selection of snacks and drinks.

With this **rail only trip**, you can select your own tour destination—**Charleston** or **Savannah**. Both cities offer a wide range of sites and events whether your interests are in **culture, railroads, colonial and revolutionary history, antebellum and civil war history, or modern history**. Both offer a variety of modern sophisticated **cuisines**, low country specialties, or opportunities to explore the differences in Georgia and South Carolina barbecues.

You might want to taxi to a downtown hotel in either city and tour either of these compact, interesting cities on foot. Neither city requires a car to see many of the **architectural and historic sites**. Alternatively, rent a car-- Hertz has a reimbursed taxi arrangement for both Charleston and Savannah Amtrak stations to get you to their nearby airport rental facilities (reservations required). With a rental car, you can stay at a hotel more convenient to **outlying sites or the beaches**. We'll return north via **Amtrak's Palmetto** to Washington DC on Sunday, November 2nd departing Savannah in early morning and Charleston mid-morning to an evening arrival in Washington DC.
